These clubs and organizations include the Naperville Women's Club to the Naperville Fire Department Women's Auxiliary. These cookbooks contain recipes which were popular among Napervillians. Also represented in this collection are other cookbooks not related just to Naperville households but to the American household. These books range from recipes centered around Jell-O to recipes compiled by staff members of the White House. Some of these cookbooks contain not only recipes, but guides for housewives in creating a better home for their families as well as tips for entertaining.
