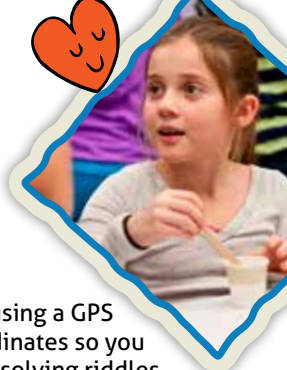

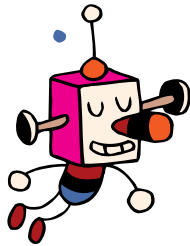
Playing With History

Geocaching and Letterboxing

Brownies: Grades 2 to 3

Juniors: Grades 4 to 5

Explore Naper Settlement's 12-acre site while using a GPS device to find hidden caches. Learn about coordinates so you can geocache on your own. Become a sleuth by solving riddles to find letterboxes. Make your own stamp and practice your skills. Program is three hours.
