Description

The Conservation Foundation was founded in 1972 to help preserve and restore natural areas and open space, protect rivers and watersheds, and promote stewardship of the environment in DuPage County. Originally known as the Forest Foundation of DuPage County, the foundation served as an official support organization for the Forest Preserve District of DuPage Country until 1988, when it became independent of the district and was renamed the Conservation Foundation of DuPage County. In 1997, the foundation expanded its range of services from DuPage County to include the counties of Kane, Kendall and Will. The foundation's headquarters moved from Wheaton to its present location at the McDonald Farm in Naperville in 1998; the 60-acre farm had been donated to the foundation by Lenore McDonald in 1992. In 2006 the foundation legally changed its name to the Conservation Foundation, and in 2007 it merged with the Fox Valley Land Foundation.

This collection documents the work of the Conservation Foundation through mailings, brochures, newsletters, and other publications produced by the Foundation. Programs on storm water management techniques, environmentally friendly yards, and the threat of non-native Asian carp to local waterways show how the foundation works to educate the public and protect the area's natural resources. Events covered include the foundation-sponsored Chase the Moon Midnight Bike Ride, the foundation's 40th anniversary "Birthday Bash," Earth Day events, and several of the foundation's membership and awards luncheons.
